The programme draws from the knowledge of a range of carefully assembled experts from all areas of the plastics waste and recycling sector including industry, local government and European associations.

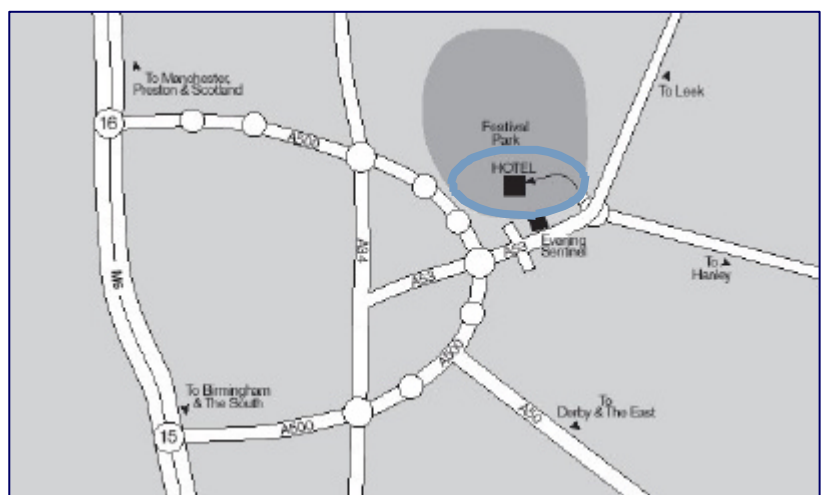
