Sajjad Karim MEP - Keynote Speaker

Sajjad Karim is a Member of the European Parliament (MEP) for North West England. Karim was the first British Muslim elected to the European Parliament on 4 June 2004. He was re-elected in 2009. Sajjad Karim is a European Parliament representative on the VinylPlus Monitoring Committee. He has authored a number of reports leading to new legislation which is aimed at cutting red tape, particularly for SME's.



Paul Bavister, Flanagan Lawrence

Paul graduated from the Bartlett School of Architecture in 1999, and is an Associate Director at Flanagan Lawrence, and a Director of Soundforms. Whilst at Flanagan Lawrence, Paul has been project architect of the RIBA award winning Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama in Cardiff, and a series of beachfront pavilions, part of the regeneration of Weymouth sea front, in time for the Olympics in 2012.



Jason Flanagan, Flanagan Lawrence

Jason is the Design Director of Flanagan Lawrence, a firm of Architects and Masterplanners who specialise in projects related to sound. Jason has a special interest in acoustics and sound. Amongst his most innovative Flanagan Lawrence projects is Soundforms, the first-ever mobile acoustic shell with the capacity for a full orchestra. This modular structure not only shelters performers, but allows musicians to hear themselves and projects sound to the audience.



Chris Howick, INEOS ChlorVinyls

Dr Chris Howick is a graduate of City University and of Nottingham University. Chris has over 20 years experience working in the PVC industry, Chris became the Product Stewardship Manager for INEOS ChlorVinyls in December 2006 and extended his responsibilities by becoming REACH Manager.

Roger has specialised in environmental/regulatory affairs and sustainable development activities for the PVC industry during the last 20 years. 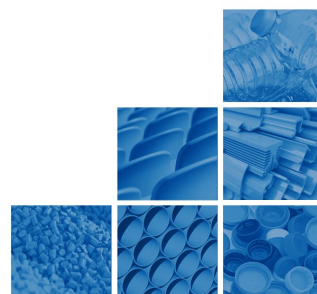


John Roddigan, Fife Council
